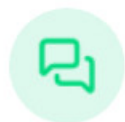


Built for active practice — not grammar lectures.

Analytical thinking, resilience and collaboration remain central to workforce transition.



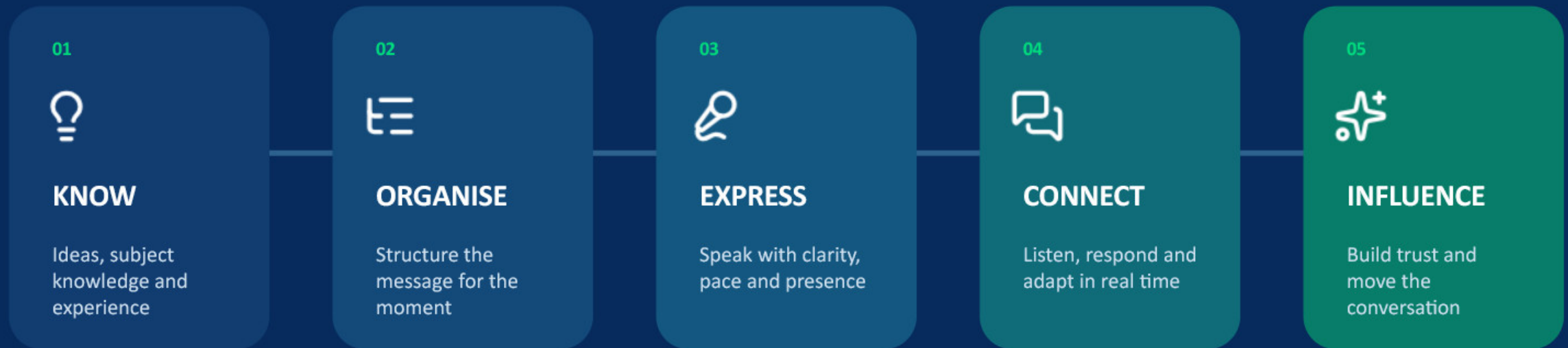
SKILLS-FIRST

Learning is moving closer to demonstrable skills.

Confidence, presence and practical communication make capability easier to recognise.

Students often know more than they can confidently show.

The challenge is rarely knowledge alone. It is turning that knowledge into a clear, credible response under pressure.



UNMUTE PRO TRAINS THE WHOLE JOURNEY

Practice the conversations that shape opportunity.

The programme is built around real student and early-career situations.

INTERVIEWS



Self-introduction, STAR stories, follow-up questions and recruiter conversations.

PRESENTATIONS



Open strongly, structure ideas, handle questions and close with confidence.

GROUP DISCUSSIONS



Enter the discussion, build on ideas, disagree politely and include others.

FIRST JOB



Meetings, status updates, feedback, workplace etiquette and professional presence.

Confidence grows through a visible practice loop.

Every session moves learners from awareness to application — with mentor feedback at the centre.



Choose a focused workshop or build a complete cohort journey.

Programmes can be adapted by department, year, level and placement calendar.

Campus Communication Bootcamp

Speaking confidence, presentation structure, group discussions and professional expression.



COHORT PROGRAMME

Placement Readiness Lab

Self-introductions, interview stories, mock interviews, body language and recruiter conversations.

Peer speaking challenges, mentor sessions and a repeatable communication-practice culture.

First Job Communication

Meetings, email, updates, feedback, workplace etiquette and confident collaboration.



PLACEMENT READINESS LAB

Make every answer clear, credible and human.

A practice-intensive track for the moments between application and offer.



Introduce

Tell me about yourself — with a story, not a script.



Structure

Use clear examples and STAR stories without sounding rehearsed.



Respond

Listen, clarify and handle follow-up questions calmly.



Improve

Use mentor feedback to retry the answer immediately.

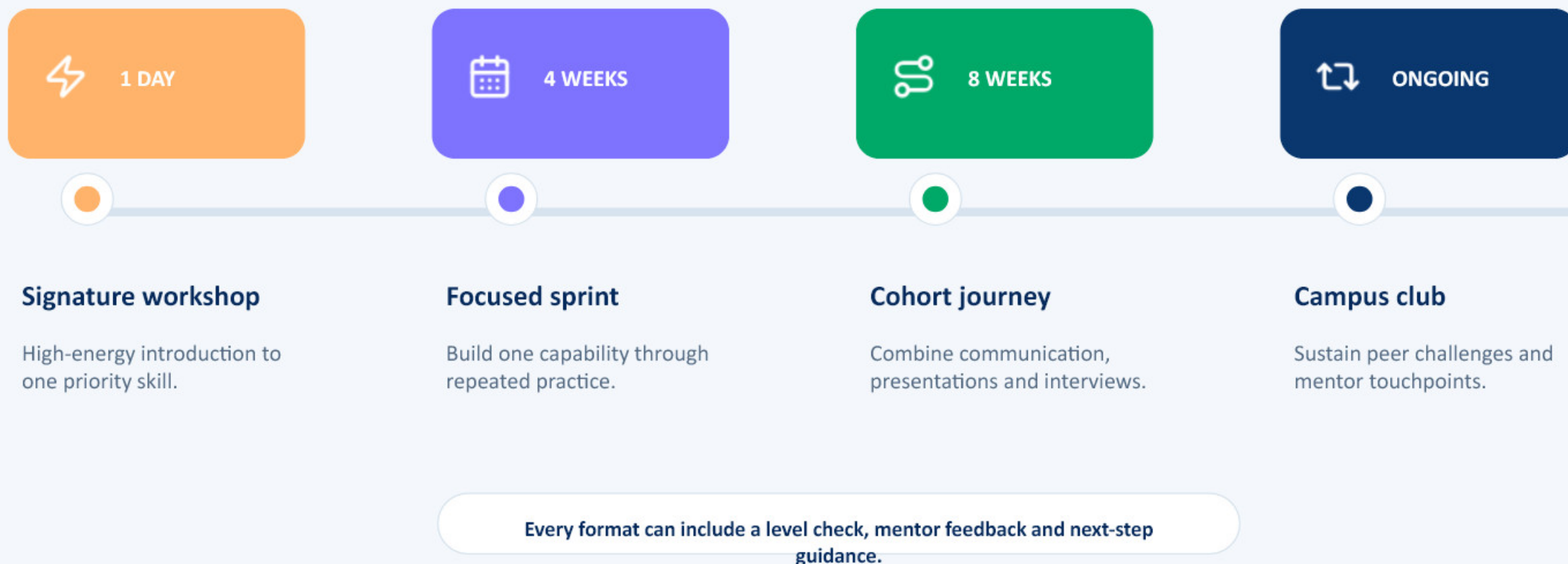
A programme your placement team can see and use.

Training can include baseline checks, participation visibility and a concise final cohort insight — not just session delivery.



Start with one moment. Scale into a campus culture.

On campus or online, with a format matched to the placement calendar and learner need.

THE MENTOR DIFFERENCE

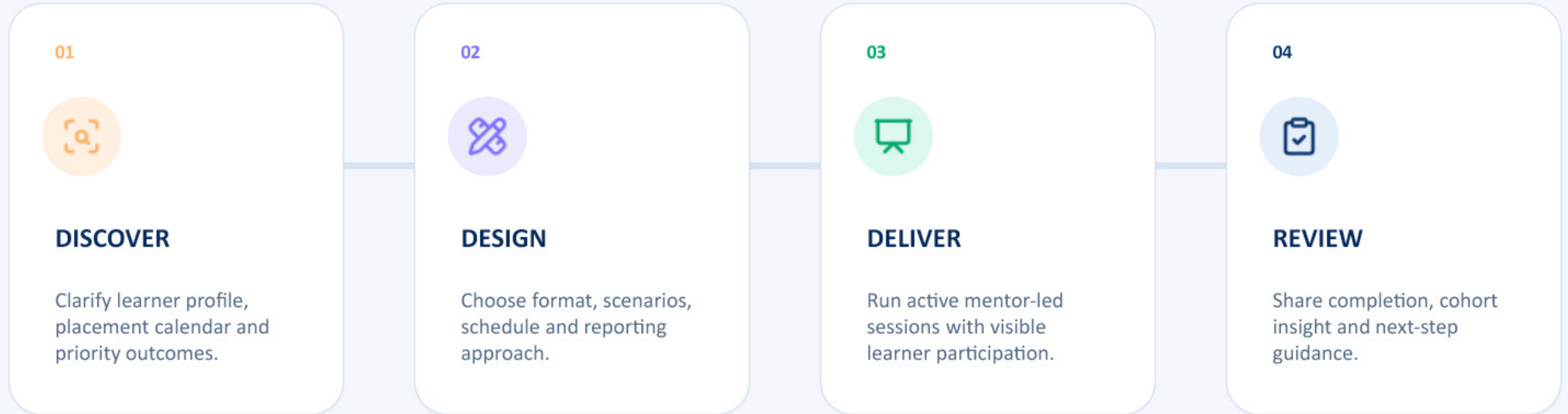
